I am pleased to inform you that the children have settled very well into our new class and that we are looking forward to an interesting Autumn Term.

Subjects to be covered this term.

Science

The main theme for this term is the science topic “Space”. Many of the other subjects will be linked to this. We will be looking at space travel, the sun, moon and earth.

English

To begin with we will be studying stories with familiar settings and then move on to play scripts. Spelling will be a high priority, alongside reading, handwriting and punctuation (our target is to improve the use of capital letters and full stops).

Maths

We will be looking at place value, partitioning 3 or 4 digit numbers and counting on in 1 s, 10 s and 100 s. We will also focus on shape, symmetry and data handling.

Religious Education

The topics covered will be Homes and Families, Signs and Symbols, Judaism and Visitors.

History

The famous people we will be learning about include Neil Armstrong and Captain Cook.

Art

Links with the Space topic and Pop Art will be studied.

PE

Dance activities and Invasion games. Please note that a yellow PE top, black shorts and trainers / plimsolls will be required.
